ABOUT GGC

OUR MISSION: Greater Good Charities works to help people, pets, and the planet by mobilizing in response to need and amplifying the good.

- We run 15 programs that work to accomplish our mission. We address root issues and unmet needs.
- We fund good work globally, enabling others to thrive and the good to grow greater. We've given grants to nearly **5,000 nonprofits in 121 countries**.
- Our program staff are experts in their respective fields, bringing decades of relevant experience.
- We work with a network of over **9,000 animal shelters and rescues in the U.S.**
- We've given over \$400MM in cash and in-kind grants, including over \$28MM in COVID-19 response.
- We pride ourselves on our impact. We value integrity, creativity, and agility.



SITUATIONAL UPDATE

- An estimated **3,866,224 people** have fled Ukraine into neighboring countries since 2/24/22, many with pets
 - Most crowded checkpoints are along the Polish border
 - Less crowded checkpoints are on the border with Hungary, Slovakia, Romania and Moldova
 - Most checkpoints are open and staffed 24/7
 - Vet care is provided at the border, vaccination on entry into country
- An additional **6.48 million people** are estimated to be displaced within Ukraine
- Refugees flow into reception areas run by Governments with substantial NGO support
- Unmet needs reported for mothers with children and animals
- Some pets are not able to travel on with family due to lack of family resources or shelter accepting pets
- This is a LONG-TERM humanitarian response. Greater Good Charities is actively supporting humanitarian efforts as well as animal efforts.

Phase 1 – Cash Support + Assessment

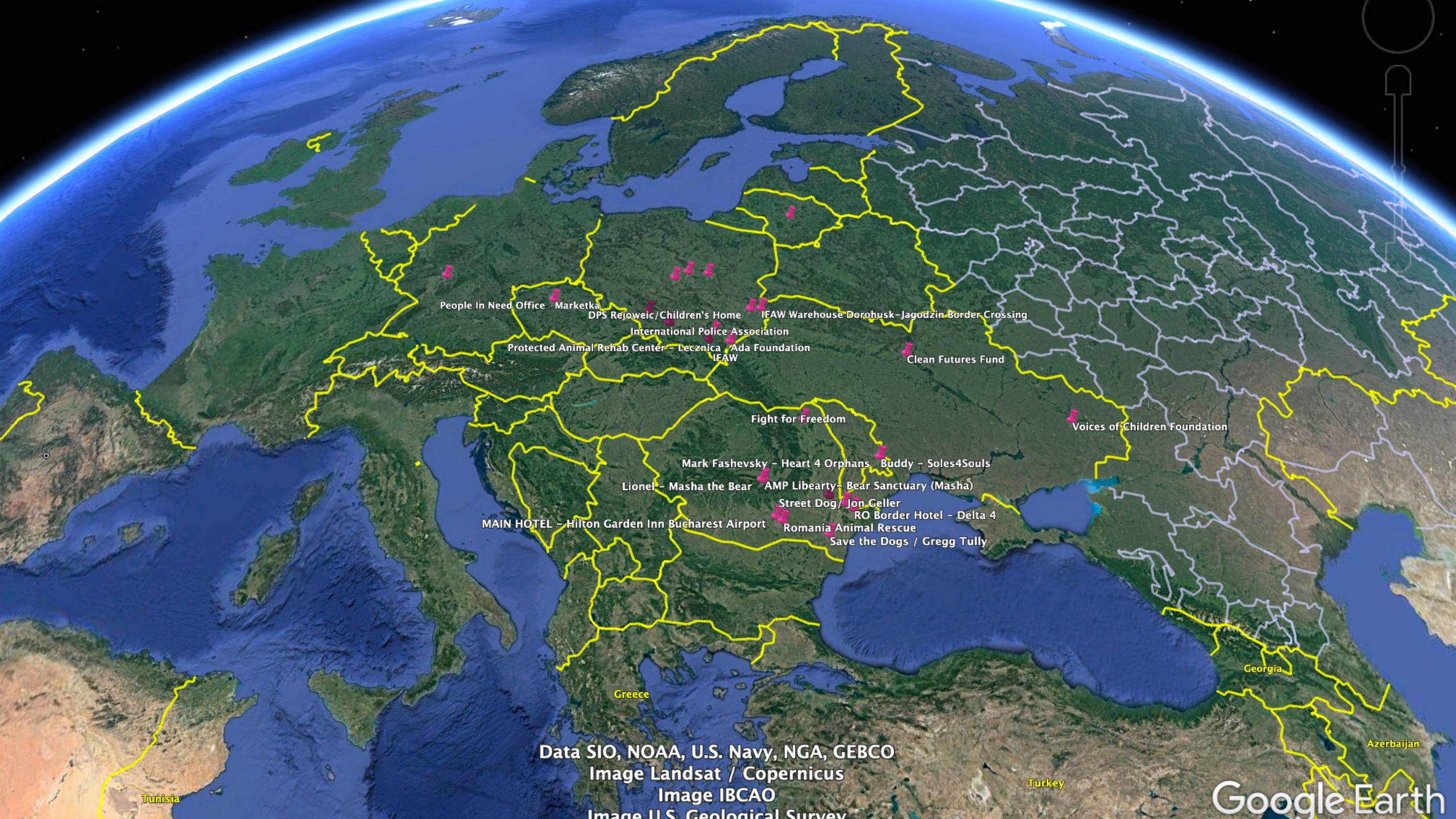
- Cash support is most urgent need
- Currently funding 23 Humanitarian and Animal Welfare NGOs, with more grants added daily
- Wildlife transport assistance out of Ukraine into neighboring countries
- Greater Good Charities ground team deployed 3/17 to identify additional NGO partners, warehousing opportunities, and biggest needs for operational support

Phase 2 – In-Country Operational Support and In-Kind

- Warehouse and distribution networks established in Lithuania, Poland, Slovakia, Romania, Moldova
- Good Packs distributions within Ukraine
- Food, humanitarian product, veterinary medicine, pet food and pet product procurement in Europe for immediate distribution into Ukraine and Europe
- Foster program support (Good Home)
- Veterinary team deployments

Phase 3 – Container Shipments and Transport

- Container shipments of hard good donations within in the U.S.
- Good Pack assembly and distribution within established GGC logistics network
- Planning for transport as needed within Europe only

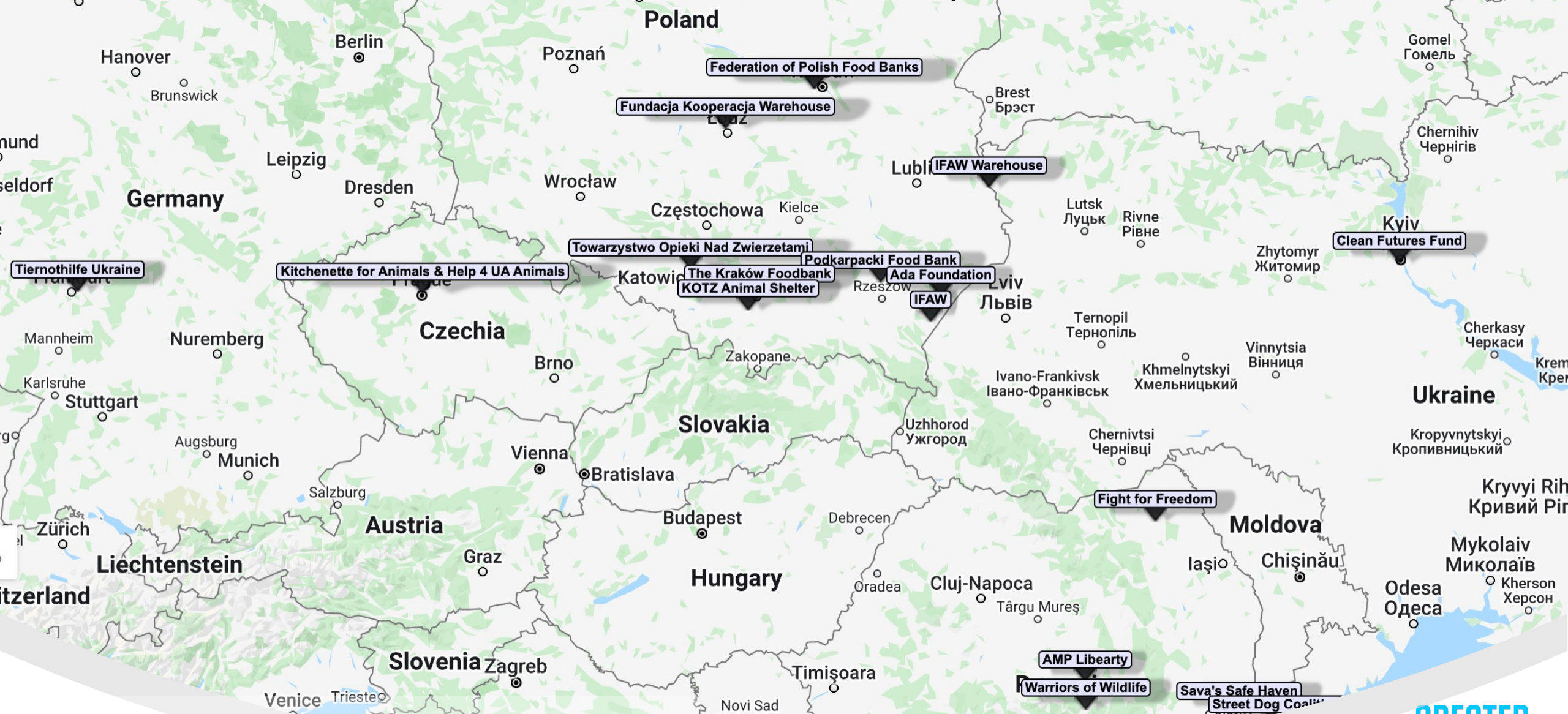

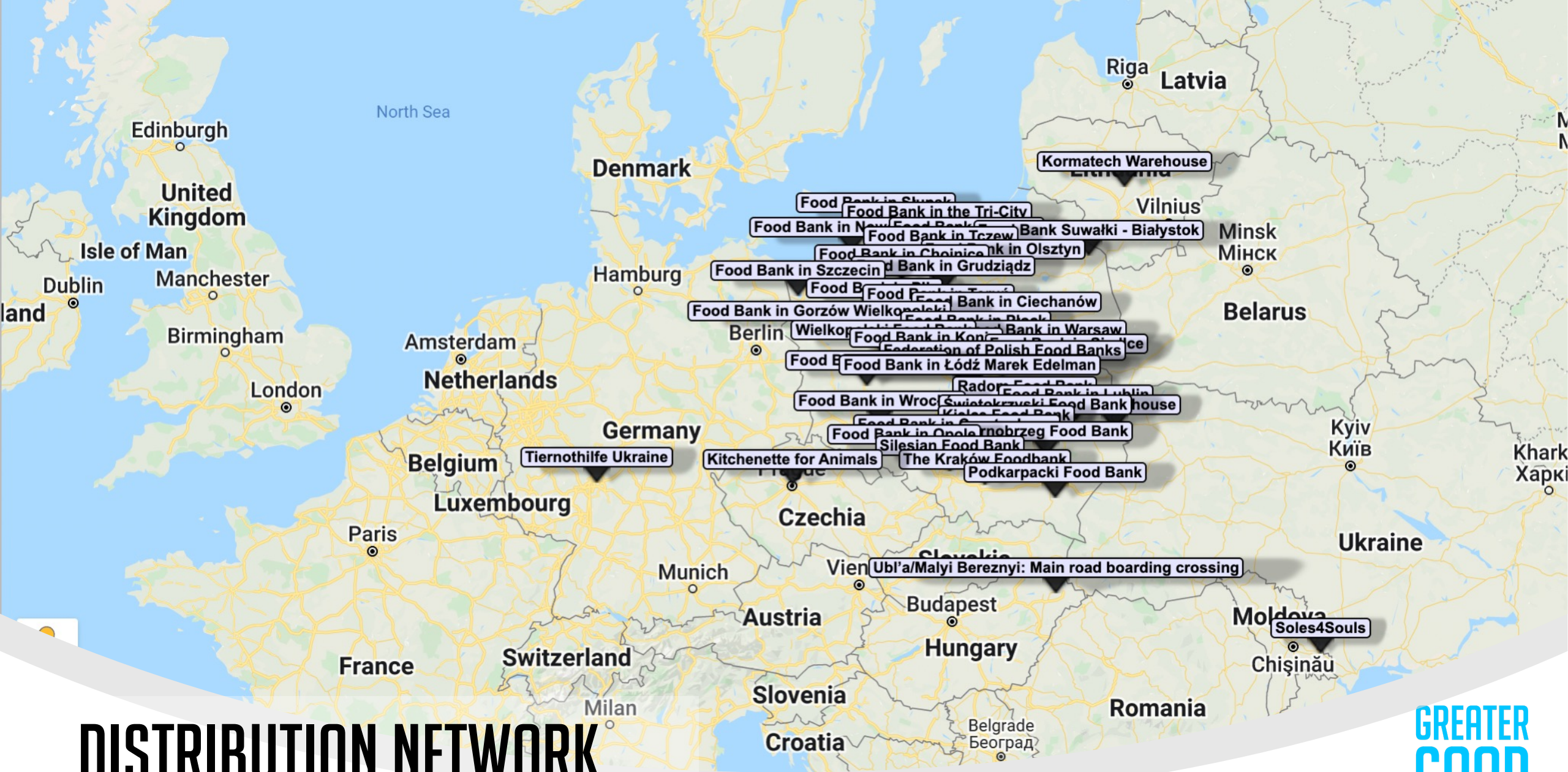

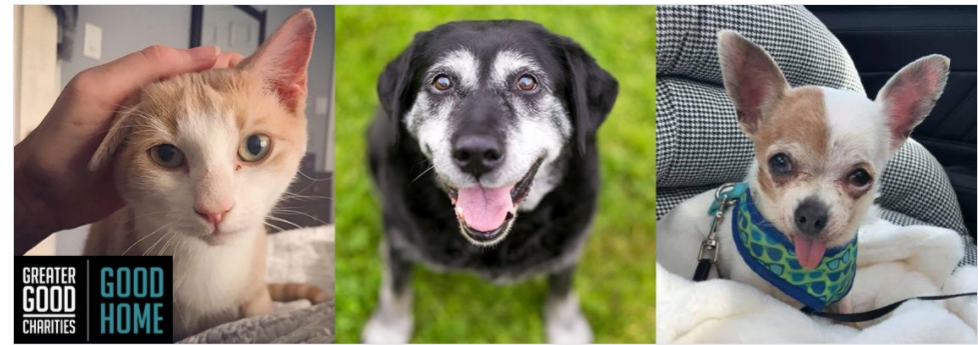

Connecting Foster Volunteers to Organizations Helping Pets Affected by the Ukraine Crisis



Thank you for offering your home in this time of crisis. The questions below will assist people seeking fosters for their owned pets or shelters seeking support for animals in their care see the foster volunteer resources available to them.

REGISTER YOUR SHELTER FOR GOOD HOME

Greater Good Charities, an international nonprofit dedicated to improving the health and well-being of people, pets and the planet. We respond routinely to global crises, natural or man-made events. As the devastation continues to unfold in Ukraine, we are seeking to support organizations providing critical aid to people and their pets, with the goal of keeping families together. We've seen many requests for short term foster volunteers online, and are offering to help you recruit fosters at no cost to you. We have collected tens of thousands of foster volunteers for animal shelters in times of need and can do this for a) your shelter animals, b) owned pets that are displaced by the war, that could help you expand your ability to care for incoming animals.

GOOD HOME UKRAINE

- Actively registering shelters in neighboring countries who need short & longer-term foster support to accept displaced pets from Ukraine
- Registered shelters receive foster recruitment support from Greater Good Charities to locate new foster volunteers
- Pets are ID'd and tracked in system through the process
- Launched in English, form translations underway into Ukrainian, Polish, Armenian, German, Hungarian, Romanian, Slovak, Dutch, French.

- Sturdy backpacks filled with essential items for people and pets
- Modular: subpacks created for different animal species
- Distributions already underway within Ukraine for displaced people
- Ongoing pack production in partnership with the Krakow Food Bank and the Federation of Polish Food Banks to support refugees and their pets

- Veterinarians already deploying under Greater Good Charities to help our partners at IFAW, Ada Foundation, and more
- Mobilizing Good Fix volunteer network (formerly ViDAS) for long term response
- Weekly rotating shifts to provide 24/7 care
- GGC is supporting Anim All Delta and Street Dog Coalition's veterinary clinic in Romania at a border crossing from Odessa, Ukraine →

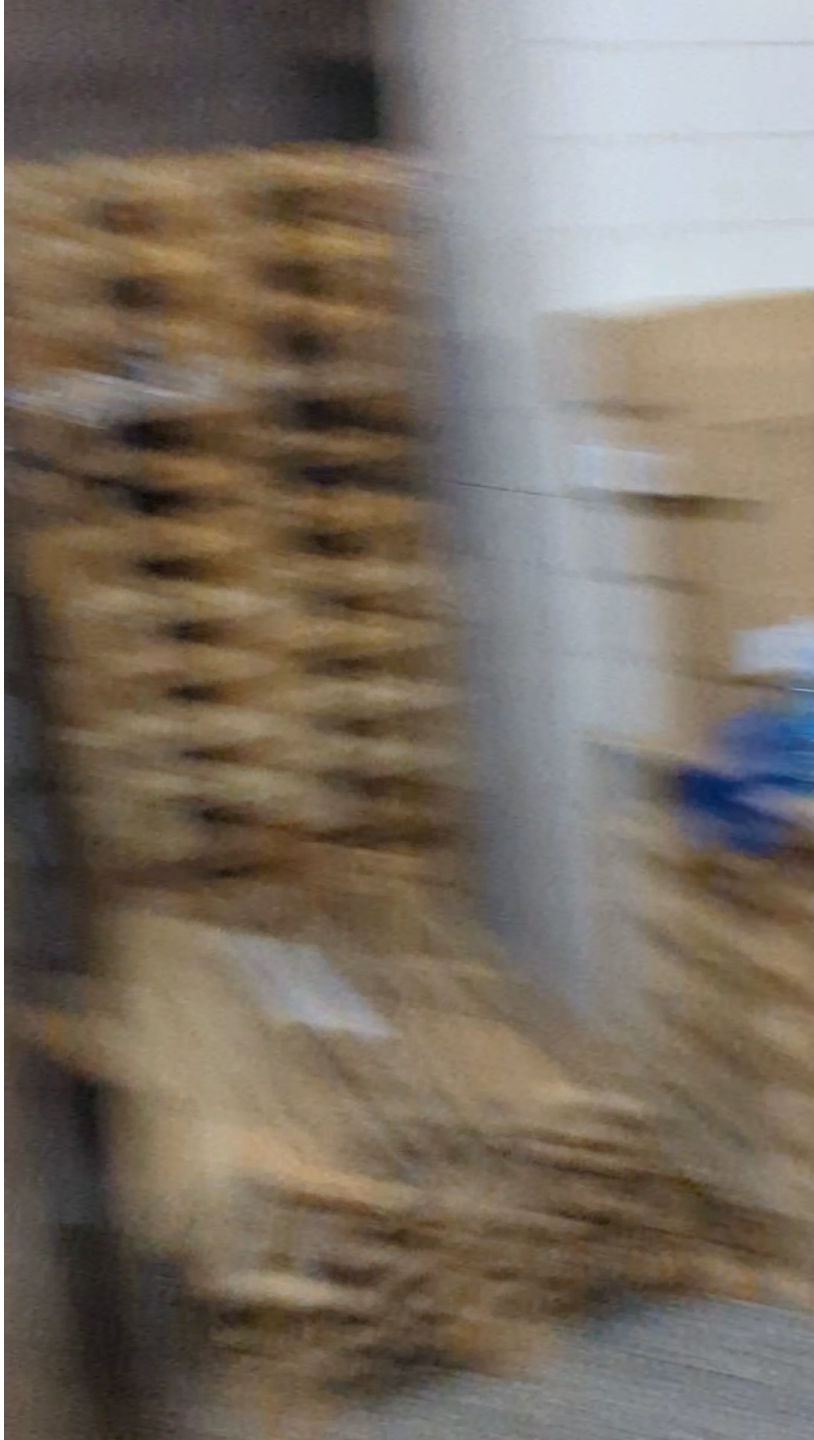

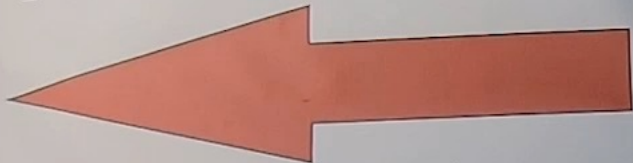
